1. Grading systems of the institutions

Grading system of Kocaeli University: At Kocaeli University, one full academic year includes two terms with an EC credit of 30 for each. Each course is graded in numbers from 0,00 to 4,00 and these grades are equivalent in EC grade and level as follows: 0,00-0,50: Fail (F), 0,50-1,50: Conditional Pass (FX), 1,50-2,00: Sufficient (E), 2,00-2,5 Satisfactory (D), 2,50-3,00: Good (C), 3,00-3,50: Very Good (B), 3,50-4,00: Excellent (A) The ECTS Credits and Grade Transformation Chart for incoming undergraduate/master's/doctorate students is available.
