1. Applications/information on nominated students must reach the receiving institution by:

 The application deadline for autumn and full year admission is May 30th and for the spring semester November 10th.

The admission decision will be made by the faculties by the end of June (autumn semester and full year admission) / end of December (spring semester admission) and the students and the coordinators will be informeddirectly by email/ordinary post.

- 3. Each student should ask for an official Transcript of Records personally at the Directorate of Academic Affairs always in the end of the exchange period. If some of the courses are at that time not recorded in the transcript, the final version will be sent to the student or to the home university within one month from the end of the semester. In this case, student should inform the Faculty International Coordinator about the missing courses and contact information.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."

F. Information

1.Grading systems of the institutions

At the University of Pannonia, the numeric scale used is from 5 (excellent) to 1 (insufficient/fail). Please note that some courses are accomplished only on pass/fail basis without any further grading.

University of Pannonia grading scale:

- 5 Excellent
- 4 Good
- 3 Satisfactory
- 2 Sufficient
- 1 Insufficient/Fail

At Kocaeli University, one full academic year includes two terms with an ECTS credit of 30 for each. Each course is graded in numbers from 0,00 to 4,00 and these grades are equivalent in ECTS grade and level as follows: 0,00-0,50: Fail (F), 0,50-1,50: Conditional Pass (FX), 1,50-2,00: Sufficient (E), 2,00-2,50: Satisfactory (D), 2,50-3,00: Good (C), 3,00-3,50: Very Good (B), 3,50-4,00: Excellent (A)

3.Insurance

The University of Pannonia's policy on student insurance requires that all international

studentshave their own insurance, and that the coverage be valid for the entire duration of the student's stay at the University.

For obtaining treatment under the same conditions as insured Hungarians, a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or Provisional Replacement Certificate (PRC) must be submitted to the health-care provider. You need both a European Health Insurance Card and your passport or ID card. The European Health Insurance Card is required for each period of treatment.
