# 1. Grading systems of the institutions

# Grading system of Kocaeli University

At Kocaeli University, one full academic year includes two terms with an ECTS credit of 30 for each. Each course graded in numbers from 0,00 to 4,00 and these grades are equivalent in ECTS grade and level as follows: 0,00-0, Fail (F), 0,50-1,50: Conditional Pass (FX), 1,50-2,00: Sufficient (E), 2,00-2,50: Satisfactory (D), 2,50-3,00: Good (3,00-3,50: Very Good (B), 3,50-4,00: Excellent (A)

Two evaluation run side by side at Vilnius University since September 1, 1993: ten-point system and pass/fail system sand work defence evaluations are graded, 5 and higher being a passing grade and 4 and lower – a fail grade. The courses that do not end with examinations use the the pass/fail system to test if a student has earned credits allocated to it. A student passes when he/she proves that he/she assimilated not less than 50% of requirements.
