- 2. The receiving institutions will send their decisions within 6-8 weeks after deadline.
  - D KIELO1: Nominated students will receive an email directly within the next two weeks with further information about the application process.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
  - D KIEL01: All students at Kiel University must order their own transcripts of records via email from the International Office. Results are available 3-4 weeks after the examination date.
- 4. In the event of unilateral termination a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Any other modification can be made by both parties at short notice. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
