- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 2 weeks after the deadline mentioned.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

This agreement is valid for the period mentioned in the heading. In case both parties agree to modify or terminate the agreement before it officially comes to an end, they are free to do so. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
